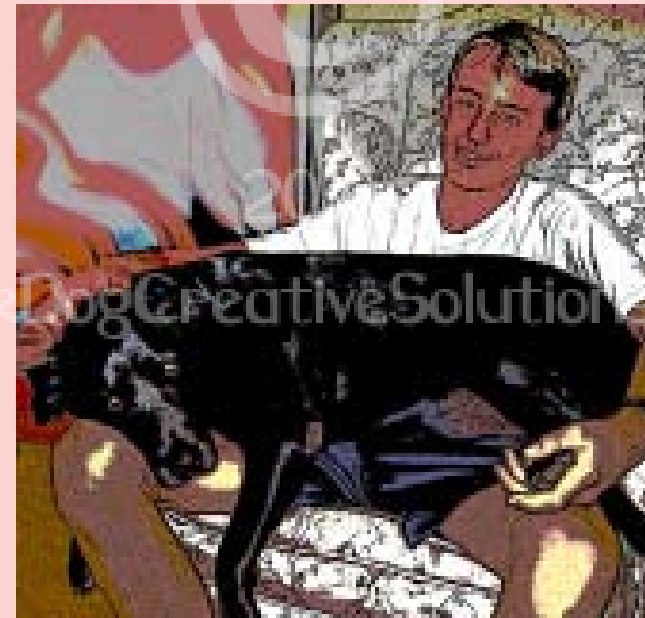

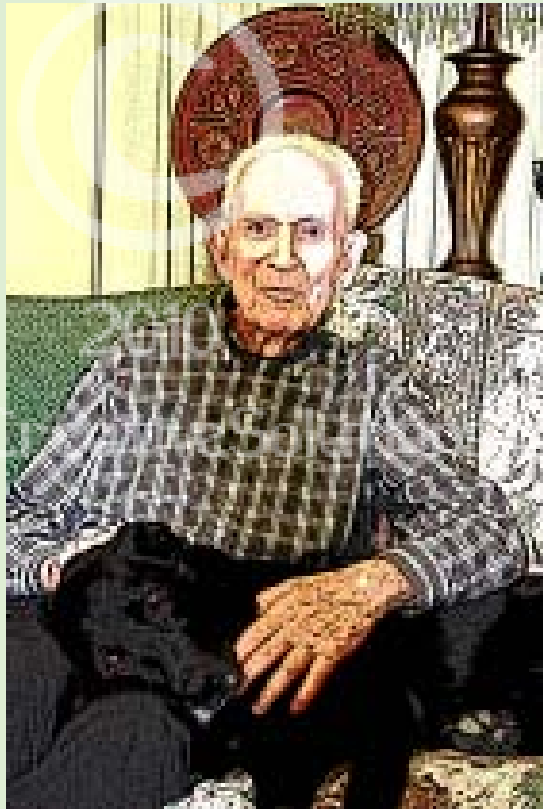

sit on the baby.



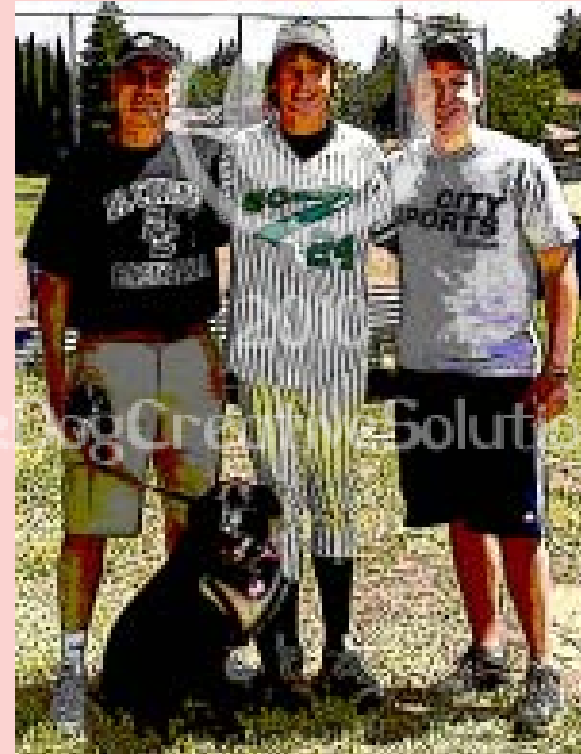
Step five

Step nine

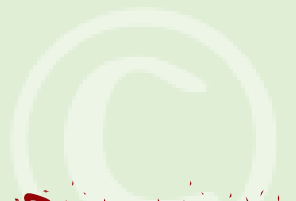
Always be available for a tummy rub.

Remember to say thank you after every treat.

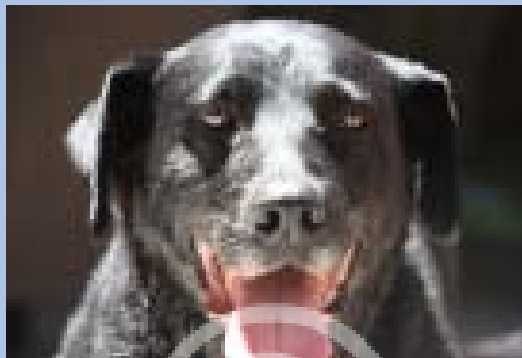
